What are End of Year Expectations?

A set of age appropriate learning objectives that children will work towards and aim to achieve by the end of each term.

Why set End of Year Expectations?

- 1. In order to ensure that we have an agreed set of expectations for what the children should achieve in each subject by the end of the year.
- 2. To monitor children's progress using the SIM Learning Observations Procedure
- 3. To foster a collaborative approach in sharing objectives so that parents, students and teachers can be partners in children's religious education.

How to set End of Year Learning Expectations

Using your manuals, please outline 6-8 learning objectives that the children should be able to know by the end of year.

e.g Class 10 Beliefs and Actions

Term 1

- 1. To understand the Big Bang Theory and Islam's perspective on how the universe came about
- 2. To be able to explain in simple terms the Cosmological Argument for the existence of God
- 3. To understand Islam's position on the Theory of Evolution

Term 2

- 1. To understand Paradise and Hell as manifestations of our own actions
- 2. To begin to know the purpose of Hell using Qur'anic references
- 3. To be able to describe the nature of Paradise using Qur'anic references

Term 3

- 1. To know the importance of prayers, including Mustahab prayers
- 2. To understand why intoxicants are forbidden in Islam
