Introduction

Text and Translation

The Holy Qur'an says:

حَتَّىٰ إِذَا أَتَوْا عَلَىٰ وَادِ النَّمْلِ

Till they came to the valley of the Ants,

قَالَتْ غَلَةٌ يَا أَيُّهَا النَّمْلُ ادْخُلُوا مَسَاكِنَكُمْ

An ant said (addressing the other ants of the valley): "O you ants! Enter your homes,

لَا يَخْطِمَنَّكُمْ سُلَيْمَانُ وَجُنُودُهُ وَهُمْ لَا يَشْعُرُونَ ﴿18﴾

So that Sulaymán and his companions may not crush you while they are not aware of it. (an-Naml, 27:18)
