You will then need to present this to your teacher and the class.</p> <p><b>Your Challenge:</b> To make a colourful and beautiful poster so that anyone who looks at it will be able to remember the Kalimah!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Build a fortress!!!</b></p> <p>Our 8<sup>th</sup> Imam, Imam Ali Ridha (AS) narrated the hadith of the 'Golden Chain' in which he stated that 'La ilaha illallah' was a fortress! And whoever enters the fortress would be safe. He also went on to explain that the conditions of entering the fortress was the love of the Ahlul Bayt.</p> <p><b>Your Challenge:</b> To build a 'La ilaha illallah' fortress. The other parts of the kalimah should be on the windows and the door of your fortress as to enter you have to say the full Kalimah.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Write a Poem!</b></p> <p>Poems and rhymes are a really good way of remembering and understanding certain things. Your poem will have to contain all the above information.</p> <p><b>Your Challenge:</b> to create a really catchy poem/rhyme so that you will never forget the Kalimah. Remember...you will have to present this to the class too.</p>
