Usul Al-Din - 9th July 2017

Aim:

Students to demonstrate how "AQAIID" (theology) the study of the roots religion (Usul Al-Din) deals with the very foundation of faith in Allah (SWT) and Islam.

Objective:

Students to present some of the five basic principles of Usul al Din through their own choice of presentation (debate, play, posters, role play, models etc.).

Task:

Prepare a presentation on one of the following topics:

1. Classical Schools of Theology and the debates on free will and predestination that took place amongst them. (explain theology and its importance and various schools of thought)
2. Classical schools of Theology and the debate on divine justice and equality. (justice=fairness?/injustice=unfairness? You can use examples from the video notes)
3. The Principles of Imamah in Quran (Quranic Verse, who has the right to choose Imams? Election or selection? and essential attributes of an Imam)
4. The Appointment of Imam Ali (A.s) (verse of Wilayah The Hadith of Thaqaalain and the declaration at Ghadir Khumm)
5. The Realm of Barzakh and the advent of Resurrection

Format:

21-5-17: Form into 5 groups and allocate a topic from above. Plan the presentation within the group and divide the work before the project day.

21-5-17: Exchange contact details with the other members of your group so you can work on the project out of Madressa hours too.

21-5-17 to 1-7-17: Prepare 1st draft to bring into class on the first day of the term

2-7-17: Bring in the 1st draft with all resources /info to complete 2nd draft.

9-7-17: Project day: Finalise and present to your parents. (Bring in all resources including glue scissors gems stickers props costumes.) A3 papers and Poster paper will be provided.

Please Note: All of the above must be backed by an Ayat of the Quran and a Hadith.
